Roles and Responsibilities – IRF Executive  
January 2010**

Sequence of IRF activities:

IRF Membership Structure: A revised preliminary motion has been prepared by Rod Phillips and Lauri Leppik based on feedback, and circulated to Members and Observers (1/1) for comment and possible further modification. Following a request for more time to discuss the changes in north America, the IRF has not progressed voting during this month. A vote on this constitution change will follow discussions and a final Motion.

Communication, branding and publicity: IRF Newsletter #150 has been distributed to all Members and Observers for their comments and corrections (NP 5/1). Feedback has been positive and most changes have been possible without increasing the Newsletter size. The Newsletter is designed to assist all organizers leading major rogaines and/or seeking land access permission. It should also assist with governments, granting agencies and sponsorships. The Victorian Rogaining Association is interested in distributing the new dark blue rogaining shirts.

WRC Entry Criteria for 10WRC and beyond: Lauri has prepared a revised version of general WRC entry criteria for Members and Observers. These will outline how WRCs will cater for Elite and Volunteer participants.

IRF Annual Incorporation Reporting: this comprises 2009 financial statement, President's report, Auditor's report, and annual statement – all for the annual general meeting.

Budget for 2010: The IRF aligns its budgeting with its Strategic Plan. The IRF Executive expects to discuss budget ideas in February 2010. Input welcome immediately.

12NARC 2010: discussions regarding the 2010 North American Rogaining Championships are underway.

Rules of Rogaining: An initial stage will involve an updating of the electronic punching (under the leadership of LL, due for distribution early 2010).
